1. Create an inventory of processes
2. Create a data map
3. Use a clear language with the public

5. Do a risk-assessment of your own data
6. Implement a way to protect the data your third parties have access to
7. Assess your internal security programmes as well as those of your third parties
8. Find a way to monitor any data breach
